

Petersburg City-Wide Cleanup May 19, 20 & 21, 2010

Spring is here, and by the consensus of the City Council, the Petersburg City-Wide Cleanup will be held on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, May 19, 20 and 21, 2010 .

Articles to be picked up include old furniture, appliances, old lawn furniture, grills and scrap lumber no longer than 6 feet. There will be no duplicate runs, so items **must** be placed curb side by 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 18, 2010 to insure they will be picked up. No toxic waste materials such as paints, thinners or batteries will be picked up. A total of four (4) passenger or pickup truck tires (off the rim) per City of Petersburg address may be dropped off at the Street Department after showing proof (driver's license) that you are a Petersburg resident – Street Department address: 214 East Jackson.

Residents are reminded that according to the city nuisance ordinance, it is illegal to pile or deposit any rags, old rope, paper, old iron, brass, copper, tin, ashes, garbage, refuse, brush, litter, weeds, slush, lead, glass bottles or broken glass upon any lot, piece or parcel of land, or public or private alley.
